- Sue Milo, Technical Services System Manager, has retired.
- Michelle Steiner, Youth Program Specialist, has completed the coursework for her Master's degree and has stepped down from her full-time position and started student teaching. She will work part-time during the afternoons and evenings until her replacement can be found.
- Susan Bushnell, Youth Literacy Coordinator has retired.
- Becky McKenzie has been hired as the new Literacy Coordinator. She has a Master's Degree in Reading Education from UVA and her experience includes work as a Reading Specialist for Parry

McCluer Middle School, teaching middle school English at Shelburne Middle School in Staunton, and teaching adults.

- Carol Holland, Library Assistant for Goshen, has retired.

Ms. Rasmussen gave an update on the Buena Vista City Council meeting last week. Over 21 people (including children and young adults) stood up and spoke to the council about their love of the Buena Vista Library. They also requested that library funding not be cut. There was a brief mention in the January 2020 Rockbridge Advocate stating that Mayor Frank Friedman said Buena Vista Mayor Bill Fitzgerald informed him of plans to recommend cutting funding for the Buena Vista Library. Mayor Fitzgerald announced at the same council meeting that his comment to Mayor Friedman has not been discussed by Council and had come only from him.
