## Policy discussion & review of updated policies

Mr. McWilliams announced after the 2% pay increase for Mrs. Goyette some board members wanted to do something else for her on their own. An additional \$4,000.00 was donated by individual trustees for a one-time gift to Mrs. Goyette. Mrs. Goyette thanked everyone who contributed to this additional money.

## Library Director's update

- Mrs. Goyette received a telephone call from Buena Vista Director of Community & Economic Development, Tom Roberts. He discussed the purchase of the "Green Space" across from the Buena Vista Library by the City of Buena Vista. At this time there is just discussion about developing the property.
- Mayor Fitzgerald called and asked Mrs. Goyette if they could meet. A meeting was scheduled for Wednesday, February 17.
- Mrs. Heslep and Mrs. Goyette attended a virtual meeting of the Rockbridge County Budget meeting last week. Mrs. Goyette was pleased to report that the full budget request from the library went into the budget. Mrs. Goyette thanked Mrs. Heslep for attending this meeting with her.

Mr. McWilliams reported that the Bath Board of Supervisors are meeting in person. The budget request for Bath includes a 10% increase from last year.
